Dear Royal HaskoningDHV,

Thank you for submitting your greenhouse gas emission reduction targets to the Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) for a net-zero validation.

Our team has assessed Royal HaskoningDHV's near and long-term targets against the SBTi net-zero criteria and criteria (version 5) and after careful review, we are happy to inform you that your submitted targets have been approved.

Basic information about your company and the approved targets will be listed on the <u>Science</u> <u>Based Targets website</u>. The following agreed target wording will be used:

## Overall Net-Zero Target

Royal HaskoningDHV commits to reach net-zero greenhouse gas emissions across the value chain by 2050 from a 2019 base year.

## **Near-Term Targets**

Royal HaskoningDHV commits to reduce absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions 95% by 2030 from a 2019 base year\*. Royal HaskoningDHV also commits to increase annual sourcing of renewable electricity from 80% in a 2019 to 100% by 2030. Royal HaskoningDHV also commits to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions 67% by 2030 from a 2019 base year.

\* The target boundary includes biogenic emissions and removals from bioenergy feedstocks.

## Long-Term Targets

Royal HaskoningDHV commits to maintain a minimum of 95% absolute scope 1 and 2 GHG emissions reductions from 2030 through 2050 from a 2019 base year\*. Royal HaskoningDHV also commits to reduce absolute scope 3 GHG emissions 90% by 2050 from a 2019 base year.

\* The target boundary includes biogenic emissions and removals from bioenergy feedstocks.

Since your company is in the first group of companies to receive approval for net-zero targets, the feedback report is not yet available at this time and will be sent when finalized internally.
