IMPLEMENTING THE MODERN SLAVERY ACT 2015

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risks Royal HaskoningDHV:

1. Has prepared a policy relating to the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and published this on our website (<https://www.royalhaskoningdhv.com/en-gb/about-us/integrity>).


2. Has implemented training to Royal HaskoningDHV staff to ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our business as appropriate.
3. Created Integrity Moments as a mandatory topic on the agenda of all Royal HaskoningDHV staff meetings in order to raise further awareness and to enable our staff to share and discuss matters.
4. Will provide all new employees with a copy of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 policy and the Global Code of Business Principles. During an induction programme new employees are made aware of the standards and values set out in the aforementioned policies.
5. Has amended Royal HaskoningDHV's terms of business and standard sub-consultancy agreement to ensure our clients and suppliers maintain their own policies and procedures and are compliant with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
6. Has implemented annual internal audits to assess compliance with the Modern Slavery Act 2015.
7. Has incorporated the Modern Slavery Act 2015 in the annual external audit carried out by independent auditors of SGS, world's leading inspection and verification company for ETHIC Intelligence. This has resulted in the certification of our Anti-Corruption Management System incorporating Modern Slavery, Human Trafficking, Child and Forced Labour. FURTHER STEPS

As part of our ongoing compliance effort we will continue to monitor, assess and further implement steps to ensure that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our business.
