

Regional BIM Manager Job Description

ROLE DESCRIPTION:

As BIM Manager you will define the BIM strategy for the region and align with the global BIM Level 2 vision, as well as develop and implement standards and provide technical support.

In projects you are responsible for the process and system technical setup and the coordination of the BIM specific aspect of the design process. You are responsible for the design and testing of the building model and the generation of information for the production. In addition to your knowledge of the building process, communication with various people and parties, your insight into data processing and developments on ICT is also important.

As a BIM Manager, you are accountable to the Project Director / Project Manager or you work under the supervision of the Technical Director. You often act as a BIM Manager or Coordinator. You have close contact with the project engineers, modellers, but also with external parties (Clients, suppliers, subcontractors, architectural firms and engineering firms that act as aspect consultants).

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Responsible for developing, updating and maintaining BIM Standards and Databases.
- Responsible for the implementation of BIM Level 2 in the region.
- Ensure sure the global company goals set by the Global BIM Task Force are met.
- Develop the BIM Execution Plan and all appendices and consult other Stakeholders.
- Manage Task Information Delivery Plan and Master Information Delivery Plan.
- Responsible for setting up the entire BIM Process and the technical BIM Uses.
- Set up the BIM workflow, communication platform, Common Data Environment and Revit Server.
- Set up all Aspect Models and link them together in a Federated Model.
- Responsible for Interdisciplinary Clash Detection and developing Clash Reports.
- Responsible for ensuring the BIM meets the Project Planning.
- Responsible to input/review/approve BIM Proposal hours and ensure budget hours are achieved for projects.
- Invite Stakeholders to meetings on regular basis.
- Consults BIM Coordinators on how to meet the technical BIM Uses.
- Consults Design Coordinators and Project Manager on impact on workload from design changes or new Deliverables.
- Responsible for maintaining the BIM Library with correct and sufficient Objects.
- Responsible to coordinate and train all Modellers, Engineers and Managers, as required, and maintain capability records.
